We have been focusing on both formal and non-formal education across generations for over 12 years, based on experimental learning, outdoor and connection with the cycle of the year. We run a Community centre, a Forest kindergarten, a Forest club, an after-school club for children, a Teenage club and we organize summer camps, also some Fantasy ones with role play and Erasmus+ Youth Exchanges.

We have hosted so far 13 long-term volunteers within European Solidarity Corps.

- 1. Educational activities:

-help to the team and set up a non-formal learning outdoor and indoor activities 3 afternoons in club for kids 6-12 years old and one evening for teenagers.

-help to initiate, start and deploy new projects and organise activities within the plan of the community centre - environmentally friendly living, music, dance, art, well being, sustainability and so..with the aim of promoting different perspectives and approaches of life. All with the support of the whole team

- 2. Content creation: set up an meetings for Youth on topics such as volunteering, cultural diversity update the social media pages (editing pictures and videos and uploading them); create posts and create small own projects up to your interests
